The board of the Greater East Side/District 2 Community Council met on May 18 to review the proposal by resident, Tony Kutzke for a 9-hole Disc Golf Course at Hillcrest Knoll Park. The board is very excited for this project and moved to support the project.

Hillcrest Knoll, although not officially a park, is underutilized space and Disc Golf would be a great asset to our neighborhood. It is a growing sport and there are limited spaces in our city to play. A 9-hole course would not greatly impact the existing benches or trails.

On Saturday, May 14, District 2 cohosted with Tony a community event and invited the neighbors adjacent to the park to learn more about the project. Over 40 people, of all ages attended and gave us very positive feedback about the proposal. Tony secured 6 baskets and many of those in attendance played. It was a terrific morning.
