- 3. Downstairs bathroom SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.17 (5) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.-Repair or replace the damaged or deteriorated ceiling. Patch the holes and/or cracks in the ceiling.
- 4. SPLC SECTION 33.03 PERMITS WHEN REQUIRED- (b). Plumbing . No person shall install, remove, alter, repair, or replace or cause to be install removed, altered, in a building or premises without first obtaining a permit to do such work from the building official.-

5. SPLC 34.11 (1), MSBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.35 (1), MPC 301.1 - Repair or replace and maintain all parts of the plumbing system to an operational condition. This work will require a permit-
