Dear Interested Parties:

This is to confirm that at the Legislative Hearing on November 22, 2022 Legislative Hearing Officer Marcia Moermond continued the matter to Legislative Hearing on **Tuesday, January 10, 2023 at 9 am in room 330 City Hall/Courthouse.**

Development partner/purchaser to submit:

- 1) **Final purchase agreement** indicating title won't transfer until the rehabilitation is complete and nuisance is abated;
- 2) submit an affidavit indicating the finances will be dedicated to completing the **project** and not diverted until a code compliance certificate is issued; and
- 3) submit *updated* work plan, including schedule

Note that proof of financing must include the cost of both the purchase price and rehab, depending on what your purchase agreement indicates you may need to submit updated financing.

<u>It is a continued & ongoing requirement that the property be maintained.</u> A sample affidavit is attached. These items can be emailed to me at Joanna.zimny@ci.stpaul.mn.us or
