Re: Remove or Repair of the Structure at <u>342 Thomas Ave</u>

Dear Manuel Crespo:

This is to confirm that at the Legislative Hearing on September 13, 2022, at which you did not appear but have subsequently contacted the Department of Safety & Inspections, Legislative Hearing Officer Marcia Moermond laid the matter over to Legislative Hearing on **Tuesday**, **September 27, 2022 at 9:00 am in room 330 City Hall/Courthouse.**

For your reference, the following items must be completed before receiving a grant of time from the City Council to rehabilitate the property:

- 1. If you are intending to have a third party rehabilitate the property, pending transfer of title, the contract used for this transaction will need to be approved by the Legislative Hearing Officer. Please note that title cannot transfer until the rehabilitation is complete and nuisance abated;
- 2. post a \$5,000 performance deposit with the Department of Safety & Inspections (this has been completed as of 9/14/22);
- **3.** apply for a Code Compliance inspection with the Department of Safety & Inspections (this has been completed as of 9/14/22);
- **4.** pay past due real estate taxes (they are currently due and owing in the amount of \$2,903.99 for the first half of 2022);
- 5. submit evidence of financing sufficient to complete the rehabilitation. Staff estimates costs to exceed \$100,000. If total for bids are more than 20% less than staff estimate, a high level of detail will be required. Financing could be business or personal accounts, a line of credit, or construction loan. Other types of financing will be reviewed on a case by case basis;
- 6. submit an affidavit indicating the finances will be dedicated to completing the project and not diverted until a code compliance certificate is issued; and
- 7. **submit work plan, sworn construction statement, or scope of work.** This should include **signed** subcontractor bids and a **schedule** for completion of the project; and



8. the property must be maintained (note that orders were sent as recently as September 13, 2022 to clean up the property).
