### 30% AMI ARPA Solicitation #2 - Overview

Request for Proposals open October 27, 2022 to November 30, 2022

**Purpose and Focus:** Increase supply of 30% AMI housing, with a focus on permanent supportive housing - primarily intended to house residents currently sheltering outdoors

#### **Funding**

- Aim to deploy remainder of total 30% AMI ARPA funding (~\$20M)
- Funds must be used for production of 30% AMI units

#### **Eligible Projects:**

- Anticipated closing date no later than the end of 2024
- Rental housing and/or permanent supportive housing, minimum of 4 units
- Project creates new 30% AMI units (new construction or adaptive reuse)
- Minimum of 10% of the units in the project at 30% AMI level
- Affordability term of at least 30 years



## **Response and Review**

11 applications received

6 projects recommended to move forward with final underwriting

Projects will be brought to City Council for funding approval individually, at later date
