Project Scope

This project involves redevelopment of 2 trails within Indian Mounds Regional Park, the trail connector for the Bruce Vento Regional Trail at 12' width, and the bluff overlook loop trail at 8' width. The trails are deteriorating, with large cracks, weeds, and differential settlement evident. This can lead to safety issues for the over 122,000 visits to this park as counted by the Metropolitan Council's 2009 annual visit count. Benches currently positioned on the opposite side of the bluff loop trail will be relocated to new concrete pads on the bluff side of the trail for better views. Some minor brush clearing may also need to be done near the bench locations t0 take advantage of the beautiful vistas to the river. The project may also include support items such as signage, ADA ramp replacements, and turf restoration. Trails will be designed and constructed to standards required in the grant manual, including:

- With regards to bicycle trails, applicants will be required to conform with recommendations contained within the 2005 "*Minnesota Bikeway Facility Design Manual*" developed by the Minnesota Department of Transportation.

In addition, Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements will be included in the design and engineering of the project:

1. Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), <u>Americans with Disability Act</u> <u>Accessibility Guidelines for Buildings and Facilities (ADAAG)</u>.

The amended accessibility guidelines include a new section 15 that provides standards for recreation facilities such as boating and fishing facilities, golf and swimming pools. Also included in the new amended guidelines, is a definition of "Area of Sport Activity" and requirements for accessible routes to the area of sport activities and sport courts.

2. <u>Regulatory Negotiation Committee Final Report on Accessibility Guidelines</u> <u>for Outdoor Developed Areas</u>.

Until incorporated into the ADAAG standards, the final report for outdoor developed areas should be used for designing recreational facilities such as campgrounds, picnic areas, trails, and beaches.
