## NOTICE OF CONDEMNATION AS UNFIT FOR HUMAN HABITATION & ORDER TO VACATE

Wesley Mugweru Gakuo/Occuants 1566 Bush Ave St Paul MN 55106-4208

Dear Sir or Madam:

The Department of Safety and Inspections, Division of Code Enforcement, has determined that the dwelling and premises at **0 BUSH AVE** is "Unfit for Human Habitation". In accordance with Saint Paul Legislative Code, Chapter 34, Section 23, the premises will be placarded on **April 28, 2023** and ordered vacated no later than **May 15, 2023**.

Your attention is called to the following provisions of Section 34.23, Subsection 6 entitled, *Vacation of Structure or Unit*:

"Any dwelling unit, structure or portion thereof which has been condemned or placarded as unfit for occupancy shall be vacated within the time set forth in the placard and/or order. No person shall occupy or let for occupancy any structure which is condemned."

THIS DWELLING SHALL NOT AGAIN BE USED FOR HUMAN HABITATION UNTIL WRITTEN APPROVAL IS SECURED FROM THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL; DEPARTMENT OF SAFETY AND INSPECTIONS, DIVISION OF CODE ENFORCEMENT.

**Principle Violations**: These deficiencies must be corrected before this condemnation and vacate order will be removed.

1. SPLC 34.23. - CONDEMNATION: This occupancy is condemned as unsafe or dangerous. It constitutes a condition of material endangerment to occupants and emergency personnel. There are no basic facilities as this is a travel trailer and camper that is being used for a living space. There is no electricity, heat, plumbing, or permanent approved structure that meets the building code or any other city codes. These are vacant lots that the owner purchased. Nothing can be stored on the vacant lots.

<u>Other Violations</u>: These deficiencies must be corrected in order to bring this property into compliance with the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

2. SPLC 34.08. - EXTERIOR SANITATION: All exterior property areas to be maintained in a clean, safe, and sanitary condition, free from accumulation of garbage, mixed municipal solid waste, animal feces or refuse. Immediately remove improperly stored or accumulated refuse including garbage, rubbish, junk, vehicle parts, wood, metal, recycling materials, household items, building materials, rubble, and/or tires from the property, boulevard, driveway, alley, and yard.

No items are allowed on any vacant lot. Remove all items from the vacant lots.

3. SPLC 34.08. - STORED MATERIALS: It shall be unlawful to accumulate and store building material, lumber, boxes, cartons, portable storage containers, inter modal cargo containers or other containers, machinery, scrap metal, junk, raw material, or fabricated goods.

Remove all construction equipment, wood, tires, oil containers, solar panels, and debris from the vacant lots.

4. SPLC 34.08. - VEHICLES: All vehicles must be correctly licensed, operable, secure from unauthorized entry, and parked on an improved surface.

Remove all vehicles including construction vehicles (woodchipper, skid steer, excavator, trailers, etc.) from the vacant lots.

Authorization to reoccupy this/these dwelling unit(s) will not be given until it is demonstrated that all principal violations have been corrected and that no new conditions exist which could constitute material endangerment, or which threaten the peace, health, safety or welfare of the occupants of this building.

All repairs and new installations must be made in accordance with the appropriate codes. Permit information may be obtained from the Building Inspection and Design Section, 375 Jackson Street, Suite 220, (651) 266-8989.

You may file an appeal to this notice by contacting the City Clerk's Office at (651) 266-8585. Any appeal must be made in writing within 10 days of the date of this notice.

It is the responsibility of the property owner to keep all buildings secured and to properly maintain the premises at all times.
