NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Ronald Lonetti Lonetti's Lounge 1091 Rice Street St. Paul, MN 55117

RE:

All licenses held by JSR, Inc. A Minnesota Corporation d/b/a Lonetti's Lounge for the premises located at 1091 Rice Street in Saint Paul License ID #20030004659

Dear Mr. Lonetti:

The Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) will recommend adverse action against all licenses held by JSR, Inc. A Minnesota Corporation d/b/a Lonetti's Lounge for the premises located at 1091 Rice Street in Saint Paul. The basis for the recommendation is as follows:

On August 5, 2010, the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) - Environmental Health Division conducted an inspection of your establishment and cited you for one (1) Critical-Minor Environmental Health code violation which was: No approved means of sanitizing being used in the three (3) compartment sink.

On August 6, 2010, you were sent a <u>Notice of New Critical Violations</u> listing this violation and stating that it needed to be corrected. You were then informed that a re-inspection would take place on or after September 4, 2010.

On September 20, 2010, the Environmental Health Division of DSI conducted a reinspection and cited you for same CRITICAL—Minor violation that had not been corrected by the September 4, 2010 deadline: No approved means of sanitizing being used in the three (3) compartment sink.

You were then sent a 2^{nd} Notice of Critical-Minor Violations regarding this violation and informing you that a re-inspection would take place on or after October 5, 2010.

On October 28, 2010, the Environmental Health Division of DSI conducted a second reinspection and cited you for same CRITICAL—Minor violation that had not been corrected by the October 5, 2010 deadline: No approved means of sanitizing being used in the three (3) compartment sink.

This is a violation of Minnesota Administrative Rules part 4626.0805: "Provide and use an approved chemical sanitizer and maintain water temperature at 75 degrees to 100 degrees Fahrenheit."

As a result, per Saint Paul Legislative Code §310.05 (m) (9), the licensing office will recommend a \$200.00 matrix penalty.

At this time, you have three options on how to proceed:

- 1. If you wish to admit to the violation and you do not contest the penalty you need to do two things:
 - 1) Pay the \$200.00 matrix penalty. You can send the payment to the Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI) located at 375 Jackson Street, Ste. 220, St. Paul, Minnesota 55101-1806 no later than **Monday**, **December 20, 2010.** A self-addressed envelope is enclosed for your convenience.
 - 2) You also need to contact Abdinasir Museid, R.S., Environmental Health Specialist at (651) 266-9141 by **Monday, December 20, 2010**, to schedule a re-inspection in order to verify that the violation has been corrected. Payment of the \$200.00 matrix penalty and correction of the violation will be considered a waiver of the hearing to which you are entitled.
- 2. If you wish to admit the facts but you <u>contest</u> the \$200.00 matrix penalty, you may have a public hearing before the Saint Paul City Council. You will need to send me a letter with a statement admitting to the facts and requesting a public hearing. I will need to receive your letter by **Monday**, **December 20**, **2010**. The matter will then be scheduled before the City Council for a public hearing to determine whether to impose the \$200.00 matrix penalty and license suspension. You will have an opportunity to appear before the Council and make a statement on your own behalf.
- 3. If you <u>dispute the facts</u> outlined above, you may request a hearing before an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). At that hearing both you and the City will appear and present witnesses, evidence and cross-examine each other's witnesses. After receipt of the ALJ's report (usually within 30 days), a public hearing will need to be scheduled. At that time, the City Council will decide whether to adopt, modify or reject the ALJ's report and recommendation. If this is your choice, please advise me no later than **Monday**, **December 20**, **2010**, and I will take the necessary steps to schedule the administrative hearing.

If you have not contacted me or the inspector by that date, I will assume that you are not contesting the imposition of the \$200.00 matrix penalty and license suspension. In that case, the matter will be placed on the City Council Consent Agenda for approval of the recommended penalty.
