CORRECTION NOTICE

Dear Sir/Madam:

The City of Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspections has inspected the above referenced property on **May 18, 2023** and has determined that the following deficiencies exist in violation of the Saint Paul Legislative Code¹ (see footnote 1, below).

1. SPLC 34.19. – ACCESS: Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.

PLEASE PROVIDE ACCESS THROUGHOUT THE ENTIRE HOUSE THANK YOU!

2. SPLC 33.03 (c). - **DRYER VENTING:** Provide, repair, or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter and installed in accordance with the mechanical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.

FLEXIBLE DUCT IS NOT AN APPROVED MATERIAL FOR DRYER VENTS. PLEASE REPLACE VENT WITH APPROVED MATERIALS TO MEET CODE OR REMOVE CLOTHES DRYER AND CAP THE GAS LINE. THIS WORK REQUIRES A PERMIT.

3. SPLC 34.13. - EMERGENCY ESCAPE AND RESCUE OPENING: At least one window or door opening in every room used for sleeping purposes shall be openable from the inside and maintained in a professional state of maintenance and repair. Provide and maintain an approved opening from each sleeping room or area or discontinue use of area as a sleeping room. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989

PLEASE REMOVE THE BEDDING FROM THE FIRST FLOOR LIVING ROOM. THANK YOU!

4. SPLC 45.03. - **EXTENSION CORDS:** Immediately, discontinue use of frayed, deteriorated, damaged, or spliced electrical cords adequate to meet the building's needs. This work may require a permit(s), call DSI at (651) 266-9090.

PLEASE REMOVE ALL EXTENSION CORDS THROUGHOUT THE ENTIRE HOUSE. THANK YOU!

5. SPLC 45.03. - STORAGE: Provide and maintain orderly storage of materials. Provide and maintain at least 2 feet clearance below the lowest structural member or the ceiling.

PLEASE REMOVE AND PROPERLY DISPOSE OF ALL EXCESSIVE STORAGE FROM THE ENTIRE HOUSE. THANK YOU!

6. SPLC 34.08. - **STORED MATERIALS:** It shall be unlawful to accumulate and store building material, lumber, boxes, cartons, portable storage containers, inter modal cargo containers or other containers, machinery, scrap metal, junk, raw material, or fabricated goods.

PLEASE REMOVE AND PROPERLY DISPOSE OF ALL EXCESSIVE STORAGE FROM THE REAR YARD. THANK YOU!

You are hereby notified to correct these deficiencies in accordance with the appropriate codes. The Enforcement Officer will re-inspect these premises on or after **June 21, 2023 at 10:00 a.m.**, by which date the violations noted must be corrected. Failure to correct these deficiencies may result in an abatement and/or additional fees for re-inspection.

You may file an appeal to this notice by contacting the City Clerk at 651-266-8585. Any appeal must be made in writing within 10 days of this notice. (You must submit a copy of this Notice when you appeal and pay a filing fee.)
