LICENSE HEARING MINUTES

The hearing was called to order at 10:05 a.m.

Staff Present: Kris Schweinler, Department of Safety and Inspections (DSI)

<u>Applicant</u>: Lesley Zaun, attorney, Faegre & Benson; and Jarret Persons, District Manager, representing Northern Tier Retail LLC, owner

<u>SuperAmerica #4358</u>: Gas Station, Cigarette/Tobacco, Restaurant (1) – No Seats, and Retail Food (C) – Grocery 1001-3000 sq. ft., and Malt Off Sale licenses

Ms. Vang stated this license application went before the City Council and the councilmember referred the matter back for a legislative hearing to discuss placing additional or modified conditions on the license. Specifically, the councilmember requested language restricting the sale of malt off sale be included; those conditions being:

- 1. 3.2 Beer and beer products that are originally packaged with the intent to be sold together in multiples cannot be separated and sold by the individual bottle or can. Only 3.2 beer and beer products that are purchased from a licensed distributor, and are intended to be sold by the individual bottle and/or can, may be sold as an individual bottle and/or can.
- 2. The sale of 40 ounce bottles and/or cans of beer is not permitted.
- 3. The sale of wine and/or strong beer is not permitted with a Malt Off Sale license.

Ms. Zaun stated that they were agreeable to adding the conditions to the license. Ms. Vang stated that the conditions concerning malt off sale would be in addition to the condition already agreed upon concerning video surveillance at the store.
