



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
ON A PROPOSAL TO PROVIDE HOST APPROVAL
FOR THE ISSUANCE OF REVENUE BONDS
(ST. PAUL ACADEMY AND SUMMIT SCHOOL
PROJECT)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Saint Paul, Minnesota (the "City") will meet on Wednesday, February 28, 2024 at 3:30 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 15 W Kellogg Boulevard in the City to hold a public hearing and to hear comments, as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), on the proposed issuance by the City of Little Canada, Minnesota (the "Issuer"), of qualified 501(c)(3) bonds, as defined in Section 145 of the Code, in one or more series, issues, or advances (the "Bonds"), in order to finance the cost of a project located in the City.

The Bonds are expected to be issued by the Issuer pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Sections 469.152 through 469.165, as amended (the "Act"), in a maximum amount not to exceed \$10,000,000. The proceeds of the Bonds will be loaned to St. Paul Academy and Summit School (the "Borrower"), a Minnesota nonprofit corporation and an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, and used to (i) finance the construction of renovations to its lower, Kindergarten through fifth-grade, school, including improvements to classroom space and community space, and improvements to safety, accessibility, and infrastructure, located at 1150 Goodrich Avenue in the City, to be owned and operated by the Borrower, and (ii) pay costs of issuing the Bonds (the "Project"). The Project is located entirely within the City.

The Bonds, if and when issued, will be special, limited revenue obligations of the Issuer payable solely from the revenues expressly pledged to the payment thereof, and will not constitute a charge, lien, or encumbrance upon any property of the City or of the Issuer. The Bonds will not be a charge against the City's, the Issuer's, or the State of Minnesota's general credit or taxing powers and will not constitute a general or moral obligation of the City or the Issuer, but will be payable from sums to be paid by the Borrower pursuant to one or more revenue agreements.

At the time and place fixed for the public hearing, the City Council will give all persons who appear at the hearing an opportunity to express their views with respect to the proposal. City Council meetings are open for in person attendance and testimony, but the public may also comment on public hearing items in writing or via voicemail. Written public comment on public hearing items can be submitted to Contact-Council@ci.stpaul.mn.us, CouncilHearing@ci.stpaul.mn.us, or by voicemail at 651-266-6805. Any comments and materials submitted by 12:00 pm on February 27, 2024 will be attached to the public record and available for review by the City Council. Live testimony will be taken in person in the Council Chambers, and by telephone by registering to speak by noon on the day before the meeting.
