This division manager performs expert level managerial and administrative work directing the operations of the distribution division. Also is responsible for: strategic leadership and management; policies and budget; employee staffing, development, performance management and measures, training, discipline, and related human resources activities; compliance with federal, state and local laws, rules, regulations and standards applicable to the division.

Requirements are a bachelor's degree in one of the following: engineering, business administration, public administration, environmental science, urban planning, construction management, business management, economics, or a closely related field.

Education requirement is in addition to five years of progressively responsible water engineering and/or water management experience in the design, planning, operations, and cost estimates for construction and maintenance projects, water distribution systems, and/or wastewater conveyance and/or general construction.

A Master of Science degree may be substituted for two years of experience.

Must possess a class "A" water system operator's certificate, issued by the state of Minnesota, within five years of appointment. Must possess and maintain a valid Minnesota class D driver's license or equivalent out-of-state driver's license.
