Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

Bathroom sink - SPLC 34.11, SBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MPC 415.0220 - Repair or replace and maintain the plumbing fixture to an operational condition.-Repair or replace and maintain an approved private hand sink. This work may require a permit(s). Call LIEP at (651) 266-9090.

EMOVE PIPEZ.

STEPS ATTACHED TO PUBLIC SIDEWALK - SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) - Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.

DON'T NERO 3.

Steps on deck - SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.32(2) - Repair or replace the damaged guardrail in an approved manner. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.

SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

- 5. SPLC SEC 33.03 PERMITS WHEN REQUIRED. (b) No person shall install remove alter repair or replace or cause to be installed removed altered replaced or replaced any plumbing gas or drainage piping work standpipe system sprinkler system or any fixture or water heating or treating equipment in a building or premises without first obtaining a permit to do such work from the building official.-All of the plumbing work done was done without a permit. A permit is required to do this work.
- 6. MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-Window measured at openable height is 17inches and the openable width is 27inches. Glazed is 38inches in height by 23inches in width. Sill is 35inches This is a double hung windows
- 7. NEC 300-21 Provide for the openings through walls, floors or ceilings to be fire stopped using approved methods.-Remove the extension cord that goes through the basement floor to the kitchen for the oven
