#### Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on April 20, 2011 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

### A re-inspection will be made on May 23, 2011 at 10:45 am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. EXTERIOR ALL UNITS SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window frame.-Provide insulation for drafty windows.
- 2. EXTERIOR SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and maintain the window screens.
- 3. EXTERIOR SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.

- 4. INTERIOR ALL UNITS MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.-Provide Carbon Monoxide detectors for all units within 24 hours.
- 5. INTERIOR ALL UNITS MSFC 605.1- All light fixtures shall be maintained with protective globes if originally equipped.
- 6. INTERIOR ALL UNITS MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.-Upon inspection, double-hung windows in bedrooms of Unit 5, Unit 6, and Unit 7 measured 16 inches openable height x 29 inches openable width. Double-hung windows in bedrooms of Unit 1, Unit 2, Unit 3, Unit 4 measured 20 inches openable height x 29 inches openable width.
- 7. INTERIOR UNIT 3 MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Remove furniture from hallway outside bedroom.
- 8. INTERIOR UNIT 5 SPLC 34.12 (2), 34.35 (1) Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition.-Replace closet door in entryway, replace damaged blinds, replace missing door on bathroom vanity, replace doors on bedroom and closet, and secure plumbing access panel on bedroom wall. All work must be done in a professional manner.
- 9. INTERIOR UNIT 5 MSFC 603.7 Immediately cease using the stove or oven for heating.
- 10. INTERIOR UNIT 5 SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the floor in an approved manner.-Repair or replace the carpeting.
- 11. INTERIOR UNIT 5, UNIT 6 SPLC 34.13 (4) Provide and maintain a minimum egress window sill height of 48 inches. Refer to provide handout EW-1 for more information.-Permanently attach steps to wall under egress windows, in a professional manner.
- 12. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
