Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on October 24, 2024. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

A reinspection will be made on November 25, 2024, at 9:30AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Basement - MMC 504.1 - Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter and installed in accordance with the mechanical code. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989. **-Dryer vent is not attached or secured to dryer or to duct.**
2. Bedroom - SPLC 34.09 (4), 34.33 (3) - Repair and maintain the window frame. **-Bedroom window does not stay up when opened. Slide lock is not an approved method.**
3. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the smoke alarm affidavit and return it to this office.
