

The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on June 6, 2011 at 1:30 P.M..

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

No person shall keep or permit more than ONE (1) live Rabbit, White Rat, Mouse, Chinchilla, or similar small animal or bird, in any dwelling or on the same lot or premises with a dwelling or other premises within the city without a PERMIT.-RATS, Chinchillas, Mice, or Birds require a permit.

- 10. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 11. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 12. SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.
