Dear Ms. Lynch:

This is to confirm that on May 17, 2011 at the Property Code Hearing, Marcia Moermond, the Legislative Hearing Officer recommended the following:

- 1. Item 2 (attic) deny the appeal on the ceiling height (should not use as a sleeping room):
- 2. Item 3 (attic window) 16h by 31 w- grant an 8-inch variance on the openable height of the egress window;
- 3. Item 4 (basement) deny the appeal (need to be more organized and reduce volume);
- 4. Item 5 (front/rear doors) forthcoming (DSI staff to confirm with Jim Bloom);
- 5. Item 6 (front sidewalk) grant the appeal for the time being but may reissue in the future:
- 6. Item 7 (front steps to house) grant the appeal;
- 7. Items, 9, 10, and 11 done per Appellant;
- 8. Item 12 (main floor window) grant a 2-inch variance on the openable height of the egress bedroom window; and
- 9. Item 18 (window screens) grant the appeal.

Item 5 will be discussed further on Tuesday, June 7, 2011 at 1:30 p.m. in Room 330 City Hall. You do not need to attend.
