APPEAL SUMMARY

We are appealing the Correction Notice and Summary Abatement Order dated May 5, 2011 and May 20, 2011 respectively (attached).

We specifically request to have the Correction Notice and Summary Abatement Order stricken and removed from our record. We believe that the Correction Notice and Summary Abatement Order were not valid. Our reasons include but are not limited to the following.

We were given advice by a different inspector that conflicts with these documents. Further, there is nothing that has been cited from the ordinance that specifically addresses new lattice placed behind an existing fence or how to store it.

Despite our request, no written guidelines have been made available to us. In addition we request that the city provide the name of that individual who has been making complaints which we consider to be harassment.

The City of Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspections has inspected the above referenced property on May 04, 2011 and has determined that the following deficiencies exist in violation of the Saint Paul Legislative Code¹ (see footnote 1, below).

1. Remove illegal fence installed on the east side of the property. The fence exceeds legal height limitations, the posts are not firmly affixed in the ground and work was done without a permit.

You are hereby notified to correct these deficiencies in accordance with the appropriate codes. The Enforcement Officer will reinspect these premises on or after May 18, 2011, by which date the violations noted must be corrected. Failure to correct these deficiencies may result in the issuance of criminal charges² and/or a civil lawsuit, and possible abatement/assessment by the City. All repairs and new installations must be made in accordance with the appropriate codes. Permits may be obtained by calling 651-266-8989.

You may file an appeal to this notice by contacting the City Clerk's Office at 651-266-8688. Any appeal must be made in writing within 10 days of this notice. (You must submit a copy of this Notice when you appeal, and pay a filing fee.)
