Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on May 27, 2011 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on June 28, 2011 at 9:45 am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement East Wall SPLC 34.14 (2), 34.34 (5) Provide an approved electrical service adequate to meet the buildings needs. This work may require a permit(s), call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Install a multiple outlet source on east wall in basement.
- 2. Basement Freezer Cord NEC 440.13 For cord-connected equipment such as room air conditioners, household refrigerators and freezers, drinking water coolers, and beverage dispensers, a separable connector or an attachment plug and receptacle shall be permitted to serve as the disconnecting means. The appliance must plug directly into a permanent outlet.-Plug freezer directly into wall outlet.
- 3. Basement Gas Pipe MFGC 404.12 Provide leak tight caps or plugs on disconnected or unused gas lines.-Install missing gas cap on gas pipe in basement between dryer and freezer. Install missing strap for unsecure gas pipe.

- 4. Basement Panel Board Schedule NEC 408.4 Circuit Directory or Circuit Identification.-Fill out breaker schedule in panel box.
- 5. Basement Water Heater Relief Pipe UMC 2127 Install, replace or repair hot water pipes with brass, copper black wrought iron or steel. Copper must be type K, L or M. All pipes must have proper supports. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Remove existing relief pipe and install a 4 foot copper pipe.
- 6. Exterior Gutters and Soffits SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.-Peeling paint found throughout gutters, soffits and eaves. Scrap and paint gutters, soffits and eaves.
- 7. Main Floor CO Detector MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.-Install missing CO detector in main floor hallway.
- 8. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 9. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
