Your building was inspected on May 27, 2011 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

# A re-inspection will be made on July 13, 2011 at 1:00pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

#### DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Basement - Water Heater - MSFC 105.1.1 - Permits are required for the new installation of a water heater.-Obtain the required permit for the newly installed water heater. Contact plumbing inspector, Steve Fernland 651-266-9052, for final inspection of the water heater installation.

- Basement Water Heater SPC 4715.1800.9, 2210 Provide pressure relief valve for hot water heater piped to within 18 inches of the floor.
- 3. Egress Window Main Floor South Bedroom MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.

### Main Floor South Bedroom (Double-hung)

20h x 25w - Openable 41h x 24w - Glazed

- 4. Exterior Siding, Soffit, and Fascia SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.-Scrape all flaking/chipped paint on the siding, soffit, and fascia. Maintain all exterior surfaces in a good state of repairs and protected against elements of the weather.
- 5. Main Floor Kitchen SPLC 34.12 (2), 34.35 (1) Repair and maintain all required and supplied equipment in an operative and safe condition. Replace the missing knob for the burner on the gas range. Maintain the gas range in a good state of repairs and operative condition.
- 6. Main Floor Laundry Room UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work requires a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-The existing dryer vent has the wrong gauge metal. Remove the unapproved dryer vent and install a code compliant dryer vent with minimum 26 gauge aluminum or 30 gauge galvanized. This work must be done by licensed contractor under permit.
- 7. Main Floor West Bedroom SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.-Replace the broken window pane.
- Main Floor West Bedroom SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window lock.
- 9. Main Floor West Bedroom and Laundry Room SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window in good condition. All openable windows must be fully operational at all times and must stay in the open position. Repair/replace the windows that are not staying in the open position.
