FIRE INSPECTION CORRECTION NOTICE

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on April 13, 2011 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on June 20, 2011 at 9:45 AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement MSFC 315.2.3 Remove combustible storage from the fuel burning equipment rooms.
- 2. Basement steps SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.
- 3. Basement steps SPLC 34.10 (3) 34.33(2) Provide an approved guardrail. Intermediate ballustrade must not be more than 4 inches apart. Intermediate rails must be provided if the height of the platform is more than 30 inches.
- 4. Garage SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.
- 5. Lower unit MSFC MSFC 1003.3.1.8 The maximum number of locks on unit doors is two. Remove all locks in excess of two.

- 6. Sleeping rooms MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.
 Lower unit North
 23 h x 27 w Glazed 7.9 sq ft

 Lower unit South
 23.5 h x 23.5 w Glazed 6.3 sq ft

 Upper unit third floor
 11.5 h x 25.5 w Glazed 4.6 sq ft Not a Backroom
- 7. Throughout MSFC 901.6 Provide required annual maintenance of the fire extinguishers by a qualified person and tag the fire extinguishers with the date of service.
- 8. Unit entry doors SPLC 34.09 (3) i Provide and maintain an approved one-inch throw single cylinder deadbolt lock.-Back door locks currently have a one half inch throw.
- 9. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 10. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 11. MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
