RE-INSPECTION FIRE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY WITH DEFICIENCIES

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on June 3, 2011. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

A re-inspection will be made on July 12, 2011 at 1:30pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement Stairway SPLC 34.10 (3) 34.33(2) Provide an approved guardrail. Intermediate balustrades must not be more than 4 inches apart. Intermediate rails must be provided if the height of the platform is more than 30 inches.
- 2. Basement Stairway SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.
- 3. Basement Stairway SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2) Repair or replace the unsafe stairway in an approved manner.-The interior stairway was modified without permit. The stairway leading to the basement is under a trap door that is part of the kitchen floor. The basement stairway is the only access to the laundry facilities, electrical service, and furnace. There are no guardrails installed around the opening in the kitchen floor and no guardrail or handrail on the basement stairway. The height of the stair risers are 12 inches. Remove the unapproved existing stairway and install a code compliant stairway by licensed contractor under permit. Plans will need to be submitted with the permit application for review and approval. Contact DSI at 651-266-8989 to obtain the required permit.

- 4. Exterior Driveway SPLC 34.08 (7) All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9090.- Replace the deteriorated asphalt driveway with an approved surface. Contact zoning to obtain the required site plan approval.
- 5. House Siding SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.-Maintain the siding free from holes and deterioration. Replace all missing/broken siding. Protect all exterior surfaces from elements of the weather.
- 6. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
