Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

RE: 1129 SELBY AVE

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on July 7, 2011, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 33.05 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code.

A reinspection will be made on July 21, 2011 at 12:00 PM or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Back porch MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
- 2. Back porch MSFC 605.5.3 Immediately, discontinue use of frayed, deteriorated, damaged or spliced electrical cords.-Remove all temporary decorative lighting.
- 3. Back porch steps SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.
- 4. Basement windows, front door threshold and Back porch area SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration.

- All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.-Scrape and remove chipped and peeling paint. Repaint in a professional manner.
- 5. Front steps SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.
- 6. Front steps to public sidewalk SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.
- 7. Rear porch SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.31 (1) All exterior property areas shall be maintained free from any accumulation of refuse, garbage or feces.-Remove indoor upholstered furniture on porch.
- 8. Rear porch MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Move chair in front of exit door.
- 9. Throughout SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.
- 10. Throughout SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.
- 11. Utility shed north of dwelling SPLC 34.08 (5), 34.31 (3) Repair, replace and maintain all exterior surfaces on fences, sheds, garages and other accessory structures free from holes and deterioration. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-Patch hols in an approved manner.
- 12. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 13. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 14. UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
- 15. SPLC 34.19 Provide access to the inspector to all areas of the building.
- 16. Provide the inspector with a completed and signed Residential Occupancy Affidavit.
