Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on July 19, 2011. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

## A reinspection will be made on August 19, 2011 at 10:15 am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

## **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. EXTERIOR NFPA 211,9-2 Have the chimneys, fireplaces, and vents inspected for soundness, freedom from deposits, and correct clearances. Cleaning, maintenance, and repairs shall be done if indicated by the inspection.-Professionally repair damaged chimney on east side of building.
- 2. EXTERIOR SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window frames. Scrape and paint exterior window frames in a professional manner.
- 3. INTERIOR SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 4. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
