We cannot repair our roof at this time due to hardship. I (Mary Johnson) got laid off back in December of 2008 after being diagonosed with lung cancer. I have also had 3 heart attacks. Due to these illnesses we have accumulated hospital and doctor bills totalling over \$7300.00. I (Mary Johnson) just got awarded Social Security Disability in June of this year.

We also just got on the HAMP program to reduce our house payment. This program has increased our monthly house payment by \$140.00.

We have applied for a loan to fix our roof with 'Dayton Bluff Neighborhood Housing Services', but will not find out if they will help us for about 2 weeks. Our credit score is so low that nobody would give us a loan to repair our roof so we are hoping this neighborhood program will be able to help.

The City of Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspections has inspected the above referenced property on **July 19, 2011** and has determined that the following deficiencies exist in violation of the Saint Paul Legislative Code¹ (see footnote 1, below).

- 1. The roof is deteriorated, defective, or in a state of disrepair. It appears the roof trusses/joist are collapsing. Please have a licensed contractor inspect and repair.
- 2. You are hereby notified to correct these deficiencies in accordance with the appropriate codes. The Enforcement Officer will reinspect these premises on or after August 24, 2011, by which date the violations noted must be corrected. Failure to correct these deficiencies may result in the issuance of criminal charges² and/or a civil lawsuit, and possible abatement/assessment by the City. All repairs and new installations must be made in accordance with the appropriate codes. Permits may be obtained by calling 651-266-8989.

You may file an appeal to this notice by contacting the City Clerk's Office at 651-266-8688. Any appeal must be made in writing within 10 days of this notice. (You must submit a copy of this Notice when you appeal, and pay a filing fee.)

Criminal charges can be brought on the day the violation is observed, but generally we allow

time to correct unless this is a repeat violation.
