Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on July 28, 2011. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on August 17, 2011 at 9:30 A.M.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

#### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. Garage SPLC 71.01 The address posted is not visible from street. (HN-1)-Provide address numbers that contrast with the background. Provide reflective numbers or background or illuminate at night.
- 2. MSFC- 603.6.1- MASONRY CHIMNEYS- Masonry chimneys upon inspection are found to be without a liner and that have open mortar joints which will permit smoke or gases to be discharged into the building or which are cracked as to be dangerous shall be repaired.
- 3. SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.
- 4. SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.31 (1) All exterior property areas shall be maintained free from any accumulation of refuse, garbage or feces.

- 5. UMC 504.6 - Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work will require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
- 6. SPLC 34.09 (1) e, 34.32 (1) d - Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects. This work will require a permit
- 7. SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) - Provide or repair and maintain the window screens.
