Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on July 28, 2011. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made September 1:15P.M.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner.-Repair or replace the damaged or deteriorated wall coverings. Patch the holes and/or cracks in the walls.
- 2. Bedroom North East Side MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. Remove dresser bed and or storage that would prevent escape through window.
- 3. Downstairs MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.
- 4. Downstairs MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
- 5. Downstairs SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner.-Repair or replace the damaged or deteriorated wall coverings. Paint the wall. Patch the holes and/or cracks in the walls.

- 6. Downstairs MSFC 1003.3.1.8 Remove unapproved locks from the unit doors. The door must be openable from the inside without the use of keys or special knowledge or effort.-Remove sliding bolt lock from rear exit
- 7. Upstairs SPLC Sec. 34.13 3. Required space in sleeping rooms. In every dwelling unit every room occupied for sleeping purposes by 1 occupant shall have a minimum gross floor area of at least 70 square feet-Room on the west side is to small to be a bedroom 63.5 sq ft.
- 8. Upstairs MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.-various locations
- 9. Upstairs MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.-Various locations
- 10. Upstairs MN Stat 299F.18 Immediately remove and discontinue excessive accumulation of combustible materials.-Remove charcoal and charcoal lighter from apartment.
- 11. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 12. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 13. MSFC 315.2.3 Remove combustible storage from the fuel burning equipment rooms.
- 14. SPLC 62.101 Use of this property does not conform to zoning ordinance. Discontinue unapproved use or call DSI Zoning at (651) 266-8989 to convert to legal use. Discontinue: USE OF A PERSONAL OFFICE IN YOUR BUILDING.
