## FIRE INSPECTION CORRECTION NOTICE

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on July 21, 2011 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on August 26, 2011 at 2:00 PM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

## DEFICIENCY LIST



Basement south door - SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) - Repair and maintain the door frame.

- 2. Refrigerator MSFC 605.5.3 Immediately, discontinue use of frayed, deteriorated, damaged or spliced electrical cords.
- 3. Second and third floor SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner.-Patch the holes and/or cracks in the walls.
- 4. Second floor SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition.-Repair door closer.

- 5. Second floor living room SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window sash.-Window shall have hardware to hold them in the open position.
- Third floor SPLC 34.10 (3) 34.33(2) Provide an approved guardrail. Intermediate ballustrade must not be more than 4 inches apart. Intermediate rails must be provided if the height of the platform is more than 30 inches.
  - 7. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
  - 8. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
  - 9. MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
  - 10. MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.
- UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work requires a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
