#### FIRE INSPECTION CORRECTION NOTICE

## Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on August 12, 2011 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A re-inspection will be made on September 12, 2011 at 10:00 AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

### **DEFICIENCY LIST**

- 1. Basement SPLC 34.13 (1) Provide and maintain all habitable areas with a ceiling height of 7 feet over 1/2 the floor area.
- 2. Basement steps SPLC 34.10 (3) 34.33(2) Provide an approved guardrail. Intermediate ballustrade must not be more than 4 inches apart. Intermediate rails must be provided if the height of the platform is more than 30 inches.
- 3. Basement steps SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.
- 4. Bedroom windows SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window in good condition.-Windows shall have hardware to hold them in the open position.

- 5. Garage SPLC 34.08 (5), 34.31 (3) Repair, replace and maintain all exterior surfaces on fences, sheds, garages and other accessory structures free from holes and deterioration. Provide and maintain exterior unprotected surfaces painted or protected from the elements.-Scrape and remove all chipped and peeling paint. Repaint in a professional manner. Repair damaged fascia.
- 6. North of garage MSFC 605.5.3 Immediately, discontinue use of frayed, deteriorated, damaged or spliced electrical cords.-Immediately discontinue use of temporary decorative lighting.
- 7. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 8. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 9. MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.-Including behind refrigerator and gas range.
- 10. UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. **This work requires a permit(s).** Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.
- 11. MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.
- 12. MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
- 13. MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.-Including garage door opener.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
