#### Revocation of Fire Certificate of Occupancy and Order to Vacate

#### Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on September 7, 2011, for the renewal of the Certificate of Occupancy. Since you have failed to comply with the applicable requirements, it has become necessary to revoke the Certificate of Occupancy in accordance with Section 33.05 of the Saint Paul Legislative Code. A reinspection will be made on September 30,, 2011 or the property vacated.

The Saint Paul Legislative Code further provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. Failure to immediately complete the following deficiency list or the building vacated may result in a criminal citation.

#### DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Rear Exit door SPLC 34.09 (3) i Provide and maintain an approved one-inch throw single cylinder deadbolt lock.
- 2. Various locations MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
- 3. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 4. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 5. SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.
- 6. SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner.-Paint the wall. Patch the holes and/or cracks in the walls.

- 7. NEC 110-26 Provide and maintain a minimum of 36 inches clearance in front of all electrical panels.
- 8. SPLC 34.11, SBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MPC 415.0220 Repair or replace and maintain the plumbing fixture to an operational condition.-Repair or replace and maintain an approved private toilet. Secure toilet to floor.
- 9. SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.33 (3) Provide a bathroom floor impervious to water.-After securing toilet to floor caulk the base.
- 10. MN Stat 299F.18 Immediately remove and discontinue excessive accumulation of combustible materials.-Remove charcoal and lighter from the porch
- 11. MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
- 12. MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.-Double hung windows. 17inches openable height and 27inches in width. sill 27 inches. Glazed 46inches in height by 24inches in width.
