- 2. BASEMENT MSFC 1003.3.1.8 Remove unapproved locks from the exit doors. The door must be openable from the inside without the use of keys or special knowledge or effort. -Remove the slide bolt lock.
- 3. BOTH UNITS MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
- 4. BOTH UNITS MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.

- 5. EXTERIOR SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint. -Seal the open hole in the soffit and fascia.
