

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on August 29, 2011. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

A re-inspection will be made on September 23, 2011 at 1:00pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Unit 1 - West, North, and East Bedroom - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) - 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.

Unit 1

West Bedroom (Double-hung)

19h x 25w - Openable

40h x 24w - Glazed

Note: This window has so much paint on the window/frame that the window is difficult to open. Maintain windows in an operable condition at all times.

North Bedroom (Double-hung) 20h x 29w - Openable 50h x 28w - Glazed

East Bedroom (Double-hung) 17.5h x 25w - Openable 39h x 23w - Glazed

Note: This window has so much paint on the window/frame that the window is difficult to open. Maintain windows in an operable condition at all times.

2. Unit 3 - Dryer Vent - UMC 504.6 - Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work requires a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.- Remove the dryer duct that has the incorrect size aluminum. Dryer ducts must be constructed of a minimum 26-gauge aluminum and 30-gauge galvanized.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
