RE: RE-INSPECTION FIRE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY WITH DEFICIENCIES

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on August 15, 2011. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A re-inspection will be made on September 16, 2011 at 10:30 am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Basement Dryer Vent UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-Pull permit and remove old vinyl venting. Replace with solid aluminum venting.
- 2. Basement Rooms and Floors MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exit way.-Tenant is to remove and clean up material cause obstructions into rooms and material on basement floors.
- 3. Basement Staircase SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair. Install handrail leading from top step down to bottom step.
- 4. Basement Water Heater UMC 104 Correct and maintain any changes made to the original system in compliance with the mechanical code to prevent unsafe, unhealthy or overloaded conditions. This work my require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Install missing cap on top of water heater. Wires found exposed on top of electric water heater.
- 5. Interior Main Floor Bathroom SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window frame.-Finish repairing interior window frame.
- 6. Interior Main Floor Ceilings SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.-Finish repairing main floor ceilings.

7. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) - Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
