Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on July 12, 2011. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

A re-inspection will be made on August 3, 2011 at 1:30pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Basement - Dryer Vent - UMC 504.6 - Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work requires a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.- Remove the unapproved flexible aluminum exhaust duct on the electric dryer and install the approved type. Labeled and listed flexible metal exhaust duct is acceptable for approved transitions only. This work must be done by licensed contractor under permit.

2. Egress Windows - Main Floor Bedrooms - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) - 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.

Main Floor Northwest and Southwest Bedroom (Double-hung)

21.5h x 23w - Openable 48h x 21w - Glazed

- 3. Exterior Driveway SPLC 34.08 (7) All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9090.-The driveway is dirt. Contact zoning to get approval for installing the required durable, dustless surface driveway.
- 4. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
