Your building was inspected on July 21, 2011 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on August 23, 2011 at 1:00 P.M..

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. 933 electrical Room MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.
- 2. 933 electrical Room MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
- 3. 933 Health Care MSFC 1010.3 Provide and maintain approved external or internal lighting of the exit sign.
- 4. 933 Health Care MSFC 1010.1, 1003.2.10 Provide and maintain approved directional exit signs.

- 5. 933 Health Care MSFC 1010.4 Provide and maintain at least 60 minutes of illumination to the exit signs in case of primary power loss.
- 6. 933 Health Care MSFC 703 Provide and maintain fire rated floor and/or ceiling construction with approved materials and methods. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. The minimum rating must be: 1 HOUR-Drop ceiling assembly is required to have a 1HOUR rated assembly
- 7. 933 Store MSFC 1010.1, 1004.3.1 Provide and maintain a minimum of 44 inch aisles where storage or fixtures are on two sides of the aisle.
- 8. 933 Store MSFC 1010.3 Provide and maintain approved external or internal lighting of the exit sign.
- 933 Store MSFC 703 Provide and maintain fire rated floor and/or ceiling construction with approved materials and methods. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. The minimum rating must be: 1 HOUR-A 1hour rating is required for separation between commercial space and residential dwelling. The drop ceiling is required to have a one hour rated assembly.
- 10. All Residential Units MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-Measured at 22inches openable height And 24inches openable width. Glazed 19inches in height by 27inches in width. A sill height 56inches. These are sliding close windows
- 11. All Residential Units SPLC 34.13 (4) Provide and maintain a minimum egress window sill height of 48 inches. Refer to provide handout EW-1 for more information.-Sill height is 56inches.
- 12. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
