Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on August 2, 2011 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on or after September 12, 2011.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Basement - Dryer Vent - UMC 504.6 - Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work requires a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.- Remove the unapproved dryer vent containing the incorrect gauge metal. Replace with a code compliant dryer vent. This work must be done by licensed contractor under permit. Contact warm air inspector, Gary Reinsberg 651-266-9064, for final inspection.

2. Exterior - Deck - MSFC 105.1.1 - Permits are required for the new installation of a deck. There is an open building permit for the deck being installed. Contact building inspector, Dave Nelson 651-266-9027, for final inspection.
