The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date. A reinspection will be made on October 24, 2011 at 11:00 A.M..

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Bedroom North East Side SPLC 34.13 (3), SPLC 34.17 (2) Reduce and maintain the number of occupants in the sleeping rooms to: 2-Bedroom northwest side sleeps 3 over the age of 1 Reduce to 2 0ccupants.
- 2. Bedroom South west side SPLC 34.13 (3), SPLC 34.17 (2) Reduce and maintain the number of occupants in the sleeping rooms to:2-Bedroom sleeps 4 over the age of 1. Reduce to 2 occupants.
- 3. Both bedrooms MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a

minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-Measured 20inches openable height. 31inches openable width. Sill 36inches. Glazed 40inches in height by 28inches in width.

- 4. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 5. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 6. NEC 440.13 For cord-connected equipment such as room air conditioners, household refrigerators and freezers, drinking water coolers, and beverage dispensers, a separable connector or an attachment plug and receptacle shall be permitted to serve as the disconnecting means. The appliance must plug directly into a permanent outlet.
- 7. SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Replace all missing door knobs.
- 8. SPLC 34.08 (7) All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9090.
- 9. SPLC 34.08 (1), 34.31 (1) All exterior property areas shall be maintained free from any accumulation of refuse, garbage or feces.
- 10. SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.33 (3) Provide a bathroom floor impervious to water. After securing toilet to floor caulk the base.-After securing the toilet to the floor caulk the base.
- 11. SPLC 34.11, SBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MPC 415.0220 Repair or replace and maintain the plumbing fixture to an operational condition.-Repair or replace and maintain an approved private toilet. Secure toilet to floor
- 12. SPLC 34.10 (5), 34.33 (4), 34.16 Provide and maintain interior in a clean and sanitary condition.
- 13. MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-Both bedrooms double hung windows. 20inches openable height and 31inches openable width. Glazed 40inches in height by 28inches in width. Sill 36inches.
