In June of this year, I became the City of Saint Paul's 40th Chief of Police. With my appointment to this office. I have begun a revitalization of the department's strategic direction. As requested, I would like to clarify for you the anonymous donor's intent regarding his match at the Saint Paul Police Gala.
