Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on September 28, 2011. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on October 10, 2011 at 10:00 am.

**Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy**. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

**DEFICIENCY LIST** 

1. Exterior - SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c - Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.

Throughout - SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) - Repair and maintain the windows in good condition.-Repair deteriorated glazing putty as needed throughout exterior. Putty was noted to be chipped, crumbling or missing on multiple windows.

Upper Unit - Living Room - SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) - Repair and maintain the window glass.

Upper Unit - Side Bedroom - SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) - Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.-Paint the ceiling and wall where water-stained.
