Saint Paul Legislative Code provides that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. In order to re-occupy the building, the following deficiencies (if applicable) must be corrected and a complete Certificate of Occupancy inspection will be required.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior SPLC 71.01 The address posted is not visible from street. Provide reflective numbers or background or illuminate at night a minimum of 4 inches in height.
- 2. Exterior-Guardrails SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) Provide an approved guardrail with intermediate ballustrade or rails 4 inches or less apart.
- 3. Exterior-Throughout SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window frames.-Repair all rotted wood window frames throughout.
- 4. Exterior-Throughout SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.-Repair the soffits on the side of the building where damaged and missing.
- 5. Exterior-Throughout SPLC 34.08 (7) All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9090.
- 6. Interior-Basement SPLC 34.14 (2), 34.34 (5) Provide an approved electrical service adequate to meet the buildings needs. This work require a permit(s), call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Hire a licensed electrician to install an outlet for the washer and dryer to meet code, under permit.

- 7. Interior-Basement SPLC 34.13 (1) Provide and maintain all habitable areas with a ceiling height of 7 feet over 1/2 the floor area.-The ceiling height measured 6ft. 4inches but does not meet code to use for a bedroom due to the height. The owner's would like to rent this as a bedroom as there is also a exit door that goes to the rear yard along with several legal egress windows for escape.
- 8. Interior-Basement MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
- 9. Interior-Basement MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.
- 10. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
