A re-inspection will be made on November 30, 2011 at 9:45 AM.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

Exterior - SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c - Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.-Scrape and remove chipped and peeling paint. Repaint in a professional manner.

2. First floor - North porch - SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) - Provide an approved guardrail with intermediate ballustrade or rails 4 inches or less apart. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Currrent guardrail is 32.5 inches high.

√4. Interior - MN Stat 299F.18 - Immediately remove and discontinue excessive accumulation of combustible materials.-Immediately remove and discontinue storage of charcoal and lighter fluid.

Rear porch - SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) - Provide an approved guardrail with intermediate ballustrade or rails 4 inches or less apart. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.

Second floor - North porch - SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) - Provide an approved guardrail with intermediate ballustrade or rails 4 inches or less apart. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.-Current guardrail is 25.5 inches high.

Steps to third floor - SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2) - Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.

Third floor south - double hung windows - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-17 h x 30.5 w Glazed 7.9 sq ft.

Unit 1 - SPLC 34.10 (5), 34.33 (4), 34.16 - Provide and maintain interior in a clean and sanitary condition.-Clean and remove grease build up on stove top.

Garage facing alley - SPLC 71.01 - The address posted is not visible from street.

SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) - Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.

12. SPLC 39.02(c) - Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

MSFC 605.6 - Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.

MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.

5. MSFC MSFC 1003.3.1.8 - The maximum number of locks on unit doors is two. Remove all locks in excess of two.
