The issue with the railing is the steps are all very large but different size runs. Some are 12" some are as big as 16". Because of this it is nearly impossible to come up with a consisted height off the nose of the step. This iron railing and steps have been here for many years and have served the property well. Changing the existing railing to meet code will be nearly impossible due to the fluctuation in rise as well as be cost prohibitive based on the length. Estimated cost to replace without even knowing if we can make it meet code consistently through all the steps is \$2,000.00. Your granting us an appeal on this matter would be most appreciated.

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on October 25, 2011. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on October 25, 2011 at 2:15 P.M..

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Attic SPLC 34.10 (3) 34.33(2) Provide an approved guardrail. Intermediate ballustrade must not be more than 4 inches apart. Intermediate rails must be provided if the height of the platform is more than 30 inches.
- 2. Attic SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.
- 3. Basement NEC 440.13 For cord-connected equipment such as room air conditioners, household refrigerators and freezers, drinking water coolers, and beverage dispensers, a separable connector or an attachment plug and receptacle shall be permitted to serve as the disconnecting means. The appliance must plug directly into a permanent outlet.
- 4. Bedroom North side of basement SPLC 34.23, MSFC 110.1 This occupancy is condemned as unsafe or dangerous. This occupancy must not be used until re-inspected and approved by this office.-No egress

- 5. Front Steps SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.32(2) Repair or replace the damaged handrail in an approved manner. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
- 6. Front stairway SPLC 34.09 (2) 34.32 (2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.
- 7. House SPLC 34.10 (5), 34.33 (4), 34.16 Provide and maintain interior in a clean and sanitary condition.
- 8. Stair from kitchen to basement SPLC 34.10 (3), 34.33(2) Provide an approved handrail. The top of the handrail must be between 34 and 38 inches above the treads and run the entire length of the stair.
- 9. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 10. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 11. MSFC 304.1 Remove excessive combustible storage and/or vegetation from exterior property areas.
- 12. SPLC 200.02 (a) No person shall own, harbor, keep or maintain in the City and dog over three months of age without a license. Provide written documentation of current license to the Fire Inspector. To obtain a dog license, contact DSI at 651-266-8989
- 13. MSFC 605.4 Discontinue use of all multi-plug adapters.
- 14. MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.
- 15. NEC 440.13 For cord-connected equipment such as room air conditioners, household refrigerators and freezers, drinking water coolers, and beverage dispensers, a separable connector or an attachment plug and receptacle shall be permitted to serve as the disconnecting means. The appliance must plug directly into a permanent outlet.
- 16. MN Stat 299F.18 Immediately remove and discontinue excessive accumulation of combustible materials.-Remove all excess mattresses from basement. And charcoal lighter fluid
