FIRE INSPECTION CORRECTION NOTICE

RE: 1023 FARRINGTON ST

Dear Property Representative:

Your building was inspected on October 28, 2011 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on November 28, 2011 at 9 am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. Exterior SPLC 163.03, 163.01 (2), (3) Currently license (tabs) all vehicles on the property and return the vehicles to an operative mechanical condition or remove vehicles from the property.-Remove all inoperable vehicles from the property.
- 2. Exterior SPLC 34.08 (7) All parking spaces shall be paved with asphalt, concrete, or durable dustless surfacing. Before any existing spaces may be paved, site plan approval must be obtained as specified in the St. Paul Zoning Code. Contact DSI Zoning at 651-266-9090.-Remove all vehicles from the yard. Provide a site plan to zoning and pull permits for an approved parking surface.
- 3. Interior- Basement MSFC 605.1 -Provide a grounding jumper around the water meter.

- 4. Interior- Throughout SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the ceiling in an approved manner.-Patch and paint the holes and/or cracks in the ceiling in the second floor bathroom.
- 5. Interior-Egress Windows MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.-The egress windows have rotted wood, flaking paint, and no longer fit the openings. Gave the tenant and manager the information to Ramsey County Lead Paint Window Replacement Program. The windows need to be replaced.
- 6. Interior-Throughout SPLC 34.10 (4), 34.33 (3) Provide a bathroom floor impervious to water.
- 7. Interior-Throughout SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the floor in an approved manner.-Repair or replace the kitchen floor covering that is worn and torn.
- 8. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.
- 9. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.

You have the right to appeal these orders to the Legislative Hearing Officer.
