Noise Source: Jam Entertainment and Creative Services has applied for a variance to allow 24/7 operation of chillers and generators from December 26, 2011 through January 17, 2012, and the use of an amplified sound system for the events on January 11, 2012 through January 14, 2012 from 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.

<u>Location:</u> Near an enclosed track that will run from the open space to the North of the St. Paul Cathedral and East of 231 Dayton Avenue and terminate in the park area near the intersection of Old Kellogg Blvd and College Ave.
