Your building was inspected on December 8, 2011 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on January 6, 2012 at 1:00 pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional reinspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- 1. 2nd Floor East bedroom SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window in good condition.-Missing window cranks
- 2. 2nd Floor Rear stairs MSFC 1011.2 Remove the materials that cause an exit obstruction. Maintain a clear and unobstructed exitway.-Obstructed.
- 3. 2nd Floor West bedroom MSFC1026.1 Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished

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sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupanices handout for more information.-Casement window opening.

Height 43 in. - Width 15.5 in.

Glazed area.

Height 41 in. - Width 22 in.

- 4. 2nd Floor SPLC 34.11(5), 34.34(2), SPC 4715.0200Q Provide adequate hot water between 120 degrees F and 130 degrees F.-Hot water 145.9 F.
- 5. 1st Floor West bedroom SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window in good condition.-Window does not open.
- 6. 1st and 2nd Floor MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
- 7. Basement SPLC 34.10 (5), 34.33 (4), 34.16 Provide and maintain interior in a clean and sanitary condition.
- 8. Basement stairs. SPLC 34.10 (3) 34.33(2) Provide an approved guardrail. Intermediate ballustrade must not be more than 4 inches apart. Intermediate rails must be provided if the height of the platform is more than 30 inches.
- 9. Front entry MSFC 605.1- All light fixtures shall be maintained with protective globes if originally equipped.
- 10. Thru-out SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.
- 11. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
- 12. UMC 504.6 Provide, repair or replace the dryer exhaust duct. Exhaust ducts for domestic clothes dryers shall be constructed of metal and shall have a smooth interior finish. The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.-PERMIT REQUIRED AND INSPECTION BY WARM AIR / VENT INSPECTOR. CALL 266-9006
