The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.-Double hung windows . openable height is 22inches in height. Glazed is 46inches in height by 35inches in width. Openable width is 39inches. Sill is 27inches.
