Dear Property Representative:

An inspection was made of your building on February 13, 2012 in response to a referral. You are hereby notified that the following deficiency list must be corrected immediately. A reinspection will be made on March 29, 2012 at 1:30 pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or revocation of the Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

- SBC 3405.1, SBC 110.2 The occupancy group or use division of this building has been changed from 1. that previously approved. Discontinue the unapproved occupancy or use, or contact the Building Official at 651-266-9071 for a code analysis and to comply with requirements for approved occupancy.
- SPLC 62.101 Use of this property does not conform to zoning ordinance. Discontinue unapproved 2. use or call DSI Zoning at (651) 266-8989 to convert to legal use.

Discontinue unapproved use as a business with residential area. The current business use does not meet codes regarding acceptable home occupation and must be discontinued or approved by DSI Zoning. For approval as a home office, the business must:

- -Be contained entirely within a single dwelling unit in which the business operator lives
- -Have no more than one employee based on current size of this building
- -May not meet with more than one client or subcontractor on site at a time
- -Must comply with other zoning code requirement as contained in Saint Paul Legislative Code

Property has been partially converted to single-family dwelling, now with no separation between units but still with two kitchens.

-De-convert 2nd kitchen in an approved manner and obtain zoning and building approval for use as single unit residential.

-Provide fire-rated walls and construction under permit and plans to separate the building into 2 dwolling unite (dunlay)
