## **CORRECTION NOTICE**

Dear Sir or Madam:

The City of Saint Paul, Department of Safety and Inspections has inspected the above referenced property on **January 24, 2012** and has determined that the following deficiencies exist in violation of the Saint Paul Legislative Code<sup>1</sup> (see footnote 1, below).

#### Exterior \

- 1. SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.
- 2. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (1) a, 34.32 (1) a Provide and maintain foundation elements to adequately support this building at all points.
- 3. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (1) e, 34.32 (1) d Provide and maintained the roof weather tight and free from defects.
- 4. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the door in good condition.
- 5. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window frame.
- 6. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window glass.
- 7. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window lock.
- 8. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window sash.
- 9. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Repair and maintain the window in good condition.
- 10. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (3), 34.32 (3) Provide or repair and maintain the window screen.

- 11. Exterior SPLC 34.09 (2), 34.32(2) Repair or replace the unsafe stairways, porch, decks or railings in an approved manner. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
- 12. Exterior MSFC 603.9- Call Xcel Energy at 1-800-895-4999 to provide vehicle impact protection for the gas meter.
- 13. Interior MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.-Hire a licensed electrician to provide outlets for all appliances to meet code.
- 14. Interior MSFC 605.6 Provide electrical cover plates to all outlets, switches and junction boxes where missing.
- 15. Interior MSFC 605.1 Repair or replace damaged electrical appliance wiring. This work may require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-9090.
- 16. Interior SPLC 200.02 (a) No person shall own, harbor, keep or maintain in the City and dog over three months of age without a license. Provide written documentation of current license to the Fire Inspector. To obtain a dog license, contact DSI at 651-266-8989
- 17. Interior SPLC 34.11, SBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MPC 4715.0200.C Provide an approved number and type of plumbing fixtures.-Hire a licensed plumber to repair the broken tub fixtures and install the basement fixtures to meet code or remove and cap the toilet, tub, and sink.
- 18. Interior NEC 110-26 Provide and maintain a minimum of 36 inches clearance in front of all electrical panels.-Remove the tub/shower that was installed without permit and is blocking the electric panel in the basement.
- 19. Interior SPLC 34.10 (7), 34.33 (6) Repair and maintain the walls in an approved manner. Permit required.-Paint walls as needed and pull permits to install the basement bathroom to code or remove the toilet, bathtub, and sink.
- 20. SPLC 39.02(c) Complete and sign the provided smoke detector affidavit and return it to this office.
  - 21. SPLC 34.11 (6), 34.34 (3) Provide service of heating facility by a licensed contractor which must include a carbon monoxide test. Submit a completed copy of the Saint Paul Fire Marshal's Existing Fuel Burning Equipment Safety Test Report to this office.

You are hereby notified to correct these deficiencies in accordance with the appropriate codes. The Enforcement Officer will reinspect these premises on or after **February 29, 2012**, by which date the violations noted must be corrected. **Failure to correct these deficiencies may result in the issuance of criminal charges**<sup>2</sup> and/or a civil lawsuit, and possible abatement/assessment by the City. All repairs and new installations must be made in accordance with the appropriate codes. Permits may be obtained by calling 651-266-8989.

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You may file an appeal to this notice by contacting the City Clerk's Office at 651-266-8688. Any appeal must be made in writing within 10 days of this notice. (You must submit a copy of this Notice when you appeal, and pay a filing fee.)

Criminal charges can be brought on the day the violation is observed, but generally we allow

time to correct unless this is a repeat violation.

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WARNING Code inspection and enforcement trips cost the taxpayers money. If the violations are not corrected within the time period required in this notice, the city's costs in conducting a reinspection after the due date for compliance will be collected from the owner rather than being paid by the taxpayers of the city. If additional new violations are discovered within the next following 12 months, the city's costs in conducting additional inspections at this same location within such 12 months will be collected from the owner rather than being paid by the taxpayers of the city. Any such future costs will be collected by assessment against the real property and are in addition to any other fines or assessments which may be levied against you and your property.

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
