Your building was re-inspected for the Fire Certificate of Occupancy on February 2, 2012. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected immediately.

A re-inspection will be made on March 5, 2012 at 1:00pm.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. Basement - Wash Machine - NEC 440.13 - For cord-connected equipment such as room air conditioners, household refrigerators and freezers, drinking water coolers, and beverage dispensers, a separable connector or an attachment plug and receptacle shall be permitted to serve as the disconnecting means. The appliance must plug directly into a permanent outlet.-Remove and discontinue the use of the extension cord used to supply power to the wash machine. Wash machines must be plugged directly into a permanently grounded outlet. Any newly installed wiring/outlet must be done by licensed contractor under permit. New electrical wiring/outlets have been installed without permit. Obtain the required electrical permit and contact area electrical inspector for final inspection.

Egress Window - MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651) - 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information.

Upper Floor Bedroom (Double-hung)

20h x 25w - Openable 40.5h x 24w - Glazed

- 3. Exterior Foundation and Brick Walls SPLC 34.09 (1) a, 34.32 (1) a Provide and maintain foundation elements to adequately support this building at all points.-The house concrete block foundation and exterior brick has severe cracks. Repair/replace in an approved manner.
- 4. Exterior Gas Meter MSFC 603.9- Call Xcel Energy at 1-800-895-4999 to provide vehicle impact protection for the gas meter.
- 5. Exterior Wood Surfaces SPLC 34.09 (1) b,c, 34.32 (1) b,c Provide and maintain all exterior walls free from holes and deterioration. All wood exterior unprotected surfaces must be painted or protected from the elements and maintained in a professional manner free from chipped or peeling paint.-Scrape all flaking/chipped paint. Maintain all exterior surfaces protected against elements of the weather.
- 6. Main Floor Bathroom SPLC 34.11, SBC 2902.1, SPLC 34.17, MPC 415.0220 Repair or replace and maintain the plumbing fixture to an operational condition.-Secure the loose toilet.
- 7. Main Floor and Upper Floor Bedrooms MN State Statute 299F.50 Immediately provide and maintain an approved Carbon Monoxide Alarm in a location within ten (10) feet of each sleeping area. Installation shall be in accordance with manufacturers instructions.
- 8. Upper Floor Bedroom MSFC 605.5 Discontinue use of extension cords used in lieu of permanent wiring.-Remove and discontinue the use of the extension.
- 9. Upper Floor MN Stat 299F.18 Immediately remove and discontinue the tire storage from within the building.
