The exhaust duct shall be a minimum nominal size of four inches (102 mm) in diameter. This work WILL require a permit(s). Call DSI at (651) 266-8989.

UMC 1346.703 - Provide 30 inches clearance around all mechanical equipment.

SPLC 34.11, SBC 2902.1, SPLC-34.17, MPC 415.0220 - Repair or replace and maintain the plumbing fixture to an operational condition.-Repair or replace and maintain an approved private toilet. Secure toilet to floor.

MSFC1026.1 - Provide and maintain an approved escape window from each sleeping 10. room. The minimum size must be 5 square feet of glazed area with a minimum of 24 inches of openable height and 20 inches of openable width. With a finished sill height not more than 48 inches. This work may require permit(s). Call DSI at (651)- 266-9090. Refer to the Escape Windows for Residential Occupancies handout for more information. Double hung windows. openable height 16inches. Sill is 42inches. Openable width is 35 inches. Glazed is 32 inches in height by 31 inches in width.
